LAST TIME OUT: Canaries avoid a sweep in Lincoln

The Sioux Falls Canaries gritted out a 5-3 victory against the Lincoln Saltdogs on Thursday night to salvage a game in a three-game series and win the season series finale between the two teams.

Nick Van Stratten lined a double down the right field line with two outs in the top of the seventh inning, scoring J.P. Ramirez and breaking a 3-3 tie. One batter later, Cory Morales knocked Van Stratten home.

The two-run lead was enough for Kyle Ruwe (9-6), who finished his start with a scoreless seventh. Kirk Clark pitched a perfect eighth to set up Alan DeRatt's 17th save in the ninth.

Ruwe pitched well enough to beat Lincoln for the third time in as many starts, despite giving up 11 hits. After Reggie Abercrombie spotted Ruwe a three-run lead with a home run in the first inning, Ruwe allowed the bases loaded to start the bottom half but yielded just one run on a sacrifice fly. He walked one and struck out three in the game.

Lincoln tied the game on back-to-back solo home runs by David Espinosa and Curt Smith in the fifth inning, but Ruwe evaded further trouble. In the sixth, Van Stratten made a potential game-saving playing by throwing out Mike Coles trying to advance to third on a single by Espinosa to end the inning.

Abercrombie went 3-for-4 with his third home run and three RBI. He has collected an RBI in seven straight games.

Marcos Rodriguez singled in the seventh for his only hit but extended his hitting streak to a season-high 11 games, matching a team-high for the season.

Danny Meszaros (2-1) took the loss in relief for Lincoln.

Bird Seeds

- **The Canaries** are third in the league in home runs (84). **Tim Pahuta** is tied for the league lead with 22. It is the seventh time a Canaries hitter has hit 22 or more in one season. The last to do so was Brandon Sing in 2011 (24).
- **On the road, Nick Van Stratten** is the Canaries top hitter, batting .344/.399/.550 away from the Birdcage with three home runs and 27 RBI in 36 games. **Ben Moore** leads starting pitchers with a 3-3 mark and a 3.42 ERA, while Alan DeRatt is the top reliever with a 3.60 ERA, seven saves and 13 strikeouts in 11 appearances (10 IP).
- **Marcos Rodriguez** has matched a season-best, 11-game hitting streak and hit safely in 19 of the last 20 games. On the current hitting streak he is 17-for-44 (.386) with seven runs, four doubles, two home runs and five RBI.

PAHUTA POWER: Tim Pahuta is tied for the league lead with 22 home runs. It is the third most in a single season by a Canaries player, and he joins six others who have hit at least 22 in one season. He is on a pace to hit 28 this year. A team and league record of 27 was set by Brandon Sing in 2010. Jermaine Swinton also hit 27 in 2001 when the Canaries were part of the Northern League.

ABERCROMBIE CLIMBING THE RANKS: Reggie Abercrombie has three home runs with the Canaries this year, giving him 50 in his career with the Canaries. That is fourth most in team history. Brandon Sing is third with 51. The team record is 65, set by Felix Pagan.

THAT'S QUALITY: Canaries starting pitchers have turned in 19 quality starts in their last 26 games. A quality start has accompanied 24 Canaries victories this year, and the Canaries are 24-9 when getting a quality start. Ben Moore and Kyle Ruwe each have 10. Starting pitching has earned a win in 27 of 32 Canaries victories this year.

YOU COMPLETE ME: Canaries starting pitchers Ben Moore and Kyle Ruwe have combined for five complete games, tied for most in the American Association (Wichita). Moore is 2-1 in such games, and Ruwe is 1-1. Each has thrown a complete-game shutout over nine innings. They are both among the league leaders in innings pitched.

GRANNIES: Four players have hit grand slams this year for the Canaries – Tim Pahuta, J.P. Ramirez, Marcos Rodriguez and Stephen King. The most recent was by King on August 7 at Lincoln. In each of the last two seasons, the Canaries have hit two. In 2010, the Canaries launched a team record seven grand slams.

THRICE AS NICE: Nick Van Stratten broke the Canaries' single-season record for triples with his 10th of the season on July 9 against Lincoln. He surpassed a record set by Tyrone Pendergrass (2003) and Patrick Reilly (2008). Although Sioux Falls Stadium is not regarded as a triple-friendly park, six of his 13 three-baggers have come at home.

MOORE PLEASE: On May 21, starting pitcher Ben Moore earned the victory in a 7-4 defeat of St. Paul to notch his 40th career win in the American Association, surpassing Charlie Ruud (St. Paul, 2006-2009) for the all-time mark. On June 21, Moore became the all-time strikeout leader, surpassing Rich Hyde (519). He currently has 576 strikeouts with Sioux Falls, already a league record.

MAGNIFICENT MARCOS: Marcos Rodriguez has taken over third place for the all-time hits record in the American Association. He currently has 663 hits in six seasons with five teams, second among active players (John Allen, Laredo). He is also third all-time in RBI with 299, second among active players (John Allen, Laredo).

CLOSE CALLS: 33 of the Canaries' 77 games have been decided by two runs or less. The Canaries are 10-23 in those contests, and 3-10 in one-run games.

IRON MAN: Cory Morales has played in every game so far.

LONG BALL: The Canaries have hit multiple home runs in 26 games. They are tied for third in the American Association with 84 team home runs. 74 of the 84 home runs have been two-run or solo home runs. Jared Clark and Tim Pahuta have combined to hit 37 of the team's home runs.

HONORS: Four Canaries have won league awards. Tim Pahuta was named June Batter of the Month. Nick Van Stratten and Kyle Ruwe were Batter of the Week and Pitcher of the Week for July 8-14. Adam Champion was Pitcher of the Week for July 22-28.

SHIRLEY YOU CAN'T BE SERIOUS: Two-time Manager of the Year Steve Shirley is in his seventh season leading the Canaries. On June 4, 2012 Shirley notched his 300th victory as a manager. He and George Tsamis (St. Paul) are the only two managers with more than 300 victories in the American Association. On August 25, 2012 he earned his 300th victory in Sioux Falls. He managed part of 2005 with the Sioux City Explorers before coming to Sioux Falls in 2007. His career managerial record is 368-357. Shirley has the most wins in Sioux Falls, where he is 335-325 all-time.

TORBERT INTO BIRDS' HALL OF FAME: One of the greatest hitters in team history received permanent recognition on July 8. Former outfielder and designated hitter Beau Torbert was inducted into the Sioux Falls Pro Baseball Hall of Fame in a pregame ceremony. His number 7 jersey was also retired with a permanent display on the outfield wall of Sioux Falls Stadium. Torbert played three seasons in Sioux Falls from 2008-2010, and he became the most decorated hitter in franchise history. He was a two-time American Association Player of the Year in 2008 and 2010, and he earned independent baseball's highest prize in 2010, *Baseball America's* Independent Player of the Year.

ALUMNI IN AFFILIATED BASEBALL

Eddy Rodriguez (2010) was signed by the San Diego Padres in 2011 and was called up to the big leagues at the beginning of August 2012. He made his major-league debut on August 2 and homered in his first at-bat, one of just 112 big league players ever to do so. Rodriguez is now with the Triple-A Tucson Padres, and he began the year with the Double-A San Antonio Missions. Yesterday he was 2-for-4 with a double, home run and two RBI. He is 10-for-41 (.244) with six RBI in 14 games at Triple-A level.
