TONIGHT'S GAME

It's game two of a three-game series between the Sioux City Explorers and the Sioux Falls Pheasants. The Pheasants won game one last night, 5-4. Sioux City is five games out of a wild card spot. The Pheasants are eight games out with 16 games remaining.

LAST TIME OUT: Pheasants walk off on Sioux City

The largest crowd of the year, 2,633, at Sioux Falls Stadium was rewarded for waiting through the final pitch on Friday night. A four-pitch walk to Mark Shorey brought home the game-winning run for the Pheasants' 5-4 walkoff win over the Sioux City Explorers in the opener of a three-game series.

With the Pheasants ahead 4-2 in the eighth inning, Sioux City battled back to even the score. Derek Schermerhorn led off with a single, and Kent Sakamoto drove him in with an RBI double to cut the deficit to one run. Reliever Brandon Rapoza retired the next two batters before Brett Flowers bounced a game-tying single past infielders Kevin Carby and Joe Anthonson.

The Birds' bats picked up Rapoza in the final frame. Will Richards reached on an error to lead off the ninth and was pushed to second on a sacrifice bunt by Joe Anthonson. Gus Milner singled and advanced to second on the play to put runners at second and third with just one out. Following an intentional walk to Reggie Abercrombie, reliever Eddie Delacruz (5-7) couldn't find the strike zone, administering the game-winning free pass to Shorey.

Aaron Cotter (1-1) pitched a perfect ninth to record the win.

The back-and-forth game was tied at three different times in the game, 1-1, 2-2 and 4-4.

"Like I've said before, we don't have a lot of quit in us," said manager Steve Shirley. "We're going to go out there and play, we're not going to lay down. So, it's never a surprise to me when we go out and do this."

The Pheasants nearly spoiled another masterful outing by starter Ben Moore, who was looking to set a new career high in wins in a season. Moore struck out nine batters and allowed two runs in seven innings pitched.

"[Sioux City] is a totally different since the last time we played them," said Moore, who has not lost in his last 10 starts. "I was really impressed with them tonight. It was a difficult night for me but the offense and defense picked me up."

After setting a club record with 14 strikeouts in his last outing at the Birdcage, the Pheasants' ace is on the verge of breaking more franchise and league records. Moore's nine strikeouts brought him to within one of tying his own league record of 126 punchouts in a season set last year.

"The only thing that matters is how we finish," Moore said. "If we would've lost tonight, I would be pretty upset, but we were able to pull it out."

Francisco Leandro homered and drove in two runs, while Abercrombie reached base in all four plate appearances with three stolen bases.

TIDBITS FROM YESTERDAY: The Pheasants had a walkoff victory for the third time this season and second time this month. The most recent was 6-5 vs. STP, 8/3/2011 when Henry Contreras singled home Francisco Leandro in the 11th inning...The Pheasants are 26-25 against right-handed starting pitching...The Pheasants are 10-9 in one-run games.

Ruwe, 28, is in his seventh season of professional baseball, all in independent baseball. The right-hander has amassed impressive career numbers with a 52-33 record and a lifetime 4.78 ERA. He has a career strikeout-to-walk ratio near 3:1 with 355 strikeouts. Last season Ruwe was 6-9 with a 6.64 ERA as a member of the Rockford RiverHawks, a part of the now-defunct Northern League. Ruwe is no stranger to the American Association. He spent his first three seasons with the Lincoln Saltdogs, appearing primarily as a reliever. Ruwe has worked exclusively as a starter in the last three seasons,

OLD FRIENDS: Sioux City and Sioux Falls, along with St. Paul, are the only three clubs that have been playing in the same league since the start of modern independent ball in 1993. Sioux Falls is 134-167 all-time against Sioux City. They have just four winning seasons against the Explorers, including last year (14-5). The Pheasants were 5-1 against the Xs at home last season. Despite playing in separate divisions, these two teams will have 16 matchups this year.

MULLIGAN: Since the Pheasants' 1-6 start to the season, they have gone 39-38.

RISING TO THE OCCASION: The Pheasants have gone 13-15 combined against the two first-place teams they have faced, Winnipeg and Gary SouthShore. Against the top four teams they have faced, the Pheasants are 19-22 (Winnipeg, Gary SouthShore, St. Paul and Wichita).

ROAD WARRIORS: After today, the Pheasants have five home games remaining and 10 games on the road.

A LITTLE HELP, PLEASE: The Pheasants are 8-12 when a starter is not involved in the decision. A reliever has been involved in 10 of the last 15 games. They are 8-7 over that stretch.

CRITICAL: The Pheasants just completed 13 consecutive division games that began on July 28. They went 7-6 with 59 runs scored. Team pitching had a 4.05 ERA (124 1/3 IP, 56 ER). The Pheasants are 20-24 against North Division foes this season.

DOUBLE YOUR PLEASURE: The Pheasants have turned 102 double plays, most in the league. Last year Joe Anthonson and Brandon Sing set league records for double plays at their positions, second and first base.

EARLY BIRDS: The Pheasants have scored 79 runs in the first inning, most of any inning. They have given up 64 runs in the first, also the highest. They have scored 28 runs in the ninth inning.

FIVE ALIVE: The Pheasants are 32-12 when scoring five or more runs in a game. They are 8-32 when scoring four or less.

I RIDE SOLO: The Pheasants have hit 72 home runs this season; 49 have been solo.

TO ERR IS HUMAN: The Pheasants have 25 error-free games this season.

UPHILL/DOWNHILL: The Pheasants have come back just four times to win when trailing after the fifth inning or later this season (4-31). The Pheasants have lost eight times when leading after the fifth inning (33-8).

PLAYER NOTES

MILNER HITTING STREAK: Gus Milner is on a season-high, 11-game hitting streak. He has gone 24-for-52 (.461) in that stretch with nine runs scored and seven RBI. Six games have been multi-hit performances. He has also hit safely in 17 of his last 18 games.

SING A SOLO: Brandon Sing leads the league with 22 home runs – 18 are solo. Sing has led off an inning 10 times with a solo home run, nearly half of his home runs.

RECORD WATCH: On August 2, Ben Moore surpassed Joel Kirsten (Shreveport-Bossier) for the most strikeouts in league history. Moore currently has 458 strikeouts in four seasons in the American Association, all with Sioux Falls. Kirsten was released by Shreveport-Bossier on August 1. He is second with 438 strikeouts.

Moore needs one win to tie the franchise record for wins in a season (Ryan Ford, 2008). It would also tie the American Association record for most career wins (39, Charlie Ruud, St. Paul).

Moore needs two strikeouts to surpass the single-season record for strikeouts for both the team and the league that he set last year (126).

Aaron Cotter recorded his 47th save with Sioux Falls on August 10 against Winnipeg, becoming the all-time saves leader in franchise history. Kris Regas (2007-2009) is second with 46.

Brandon Sing is on pace to homer 26 times this season in 100 games. He holds the American Association single-season record of 27 (96 games). Sing's 22 home run season total leads the American Association. Brandon Sing has 49 career home runs with Sioux Falls. He needs six to tie Beau Torbert for second all-time. The leader is Felix Pagan with 65.

MILESTONE WATCH:

· Mark Shorey needs two hits for 500 in his career.

· Chris Salberg needs eight strikeouts for 300 in his career.

ALUMNI REPORT: George Sherrill (2001) has appeared in 47 games this season as a reliever with the Atlanta Braves. He is 3-1 with a 3.21 ERA and 36 strikeouts. His last appearance was August 10 against the Florida Marlins. He earned the victory and threw a scoreless two-thirds of an inning. Sherrill was a 2008 MLB All-Star with the Baltimore Orioles. He now has appeared in over 400 major league games with a career ERA below 4.00.

Eddy Rodriguez (2010) was recently reassigned to the Lake Elsinore Storm, the high Class A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. This is his second stint with them this year. His most recent appearance was August 12 against Modesto. He doubled and is hitting .241 with three home runs and 10 RBI with them in 25 games. Rodriguez has already appeared with both the Padres' Double-A and Triple-A clubs this season.
